Field:

- Cultivate crops.

Management:

Winter CSA:

- Prepare share for delivery.
- Schedule driver and be available for relief driving.
- Keep records of crops distributed.
- Maintain GAP standards.

- Able to work 50 plus hours a week during the peak season.
- Good communication skills.
- Goal oriented with a history of achieving personal and professional goals.
- At least two years of vegetable farming experience.
